Under general supervision, perform power-up, maintenance, service, troubleshooting, inspection, and monitoring of machine tool and automation equipment. Main responsibilities include debugging the electrical systems but will also need to work with mechanical, fluid, and controls personnel to setup, verify, and troubleshoot entire system. Required to build and modify control panels and electrical junction boxes. Install power drops and long cable runs. Works with voltages from 24VDC up to 480VAC.
